MINISTER'S MESSAGE



Everything That Has Breath

Psalms 150 is unfortunately a section of Scripture that has made many in the Lord's Church cringe. The Psalmist dedicates the last Psalm in our collection of inspired Psalms to writing about praising God. Each of the six verses speak towards the fact that we ought to use every fiber of our being to praise God. The reason that it makes many New Testament Christians cringe is because most of it is about praising God with stringed instruments. It speaks of praising God with the trumpet, the lute, the harp, the timbrel, dance, stringed instruments in general, flutes, and cymbals (Psa. 150:3-5).

We know that this Psalm is a part of the Old Testament which has effectively been nailed to the cross of Jesus Christ (Col. 2:14). And since that is true, there is no reason that we should cringe at it. Instead, we should glean a profound truth from it. In order to live our lives how God intended us to, we ought to live towards His glorification and enjoy Him forever. Worship does not have to conclude on Sunday. As we go throughout the entire week, in whatever we are doing, we should find ways to praise God. If we have the most important thing we can do in life in mind, we can be the embodiment of the final verse of Psalm 150. It concludes by saying, "Let everything that has breath praise the LORD. Praise the LORD!"
