## MINISTER'S MESSAGE



### The Psalms' Attitude Toward Worship (Pt. 5)

Psalms 100 continues in verse 2 by saying, "Serve the LORD with gladness; come before His presence with singing." The Psalmist basically repeated himself in the first clause. He said to serve God "with gladness," which is similar to him saying, "Make a joyful shout to the LORD, all you lands!" Then he again said to "come before His presence with singing" People, in what you could call "mainstream Christianity", love to point out the use of mechanical instruments in the Old Testament. They love to point to places like Psalm 150 where the Psalmist is urging everyone to praise God with all that they have, which includes these various instruments. What many do not know, however, is that worshipping with these instruments were only explicitly approved in the worship that went on in the Tabernacle and the Temple (Num. 10:1-10; 1 Chron. 23:25-26; 2 Chron. 29:25-27). The exiled Psalmists lamented the fact that they could not pick up their instruments to sing "the LORD's song" being separated from His Temple in Babylon (Psa. 137:1-4).

God has always valued singing above any kind of playing of an instrument. He, of course, said through Paul, "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord" in Colossians 3:16 with the same basic thing said in Ephesians 5:19. Singing in the worship assembly is special. Singing allows each of us to pour out our emotions to God I believe, more so than any other act of worship. So let's be sure that we "come before His presence with singing" with a joyful and glad disposition!
