The Psalms' Attitude Toward Worship (Pt. 2)

What motivated you to be here today? What is our attitude towards worship? How do we view it? Having grown up in the Church, I understand that after doing the same thing on the same day of the week for your whole life that there is an ever present temptation to think of going to worship nothing more than part of your routine. We can get to where we are getting up on Sunday mornings and bringing ourselves to the church building for no reason other than because that's what we always do.

When thinking about this great temptation and reality for many, the Psalms paint a drastically different approach. Besides the fact that the phrase "Praise Yahweh"/"Praise the LORD" is said 39x throughout the book, it tells us that when we do so, we ought to do it with the right attitude. Whenever you realize that your attitude toward worship isn't what it ought to be, let's try to remember these words. David writes in Psalm 122:1, "I was *glad* when they said to me, 'Let us go into the house of the LORD!'"
