MINISTER'S MESSAGE



The Psalms' Attitude Toward Worship (Pt. 7)

Psalm 100 continues by saying in verse 4, "Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name." Luke 17:11-19 tells the story of Jesus healing ten lepers. After healing them, He tells them to then go and present themselves to the priests to show him that they no longer are lepers. All ten presumably do as He said so that they can be reincorporated into their normal lives. However, we're told that only one of the former lepers returned to thank Jesus. He asks "But where are the nine?" He then commends this one who returned and tells him that it was not just Christ's healing hand that made him well, but his faith as well.

Notice that Jesus didn't command these ten lepers to return and give thanks to Him. It is very similar to what our response to God should be. Paul tells us that God does not need anything, including our praise (Acts 17:25). God shouldn't have to tell us to give Him thanks for us to do so. Consider if someone were to give you a really special gift but you were to respond with a blank, emotionless face. For most people, they would never think to respond that way! How much more then should we give thanks to God for the greatest gift ever given? It should be of our own freewill and desire to thank God and praise Him for forming us and redeeming us through the blood of His Son.
