## MINISTER'S MESSAGE



### **The Beatitudes of Revelation (3/5)**

The third blessed statement of Revelation is found in 19:9. John wrote, "Then he [an angel that was guiding John] said to me, 'Write, 'Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb.'" And he said to me, "These are true words of God.'" This was said in the context of praises being offered to God in response to Him taking down the great harlot (19:1-6), who is said to be Babylon (17:5) which is a representation of Rome.

One of the most obvious symbols in the book is that of the Lamb. This is the Lamb that "was slain from the foundation of the world" (13:8). And in chapter 19, we find the marriage supper of the Lamb. Since the Church is the bride of Christ (Eph. 5:22), this would obviously be who He would be married to in Revelation 19.

What I think we can find noteworthy about this *blessed statement* is what preceded it. In 19:7 there is great rejoicing at this marriage supper. In 19:8, we find that His bride was given bright and clean fine linens, which represented "the righteous acts of the saints." What we find from these descriptions is how much the Church is loved by her Husband. Not even to mention the fact that He did give His life for her. Since He loves us (the Church) so much, we would do well to love Him back. Fortunately, He's told us exactly how we show our love for Him. When He said in John 14:15, "If you love Me, you will keep My commandments."
