## MINISTER'S MESSAGE



### **The Psalms' Attitude Toward Worship (Pt. 6)**

The Psalmist continues in Psalm 100:3 saying, "Know ye that the LORD he is God: It is He that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are His people, and the sheep of His pasture." When we come to worship, we have to recognize who it is that we have come to worship and how small we are compared to Him.

Of course when it says "the LORD", that is the covenant name of God, Yahweh. And we obviously must know who it is that we are coming to worship. We have come to worship the God who in the beginning created the universe (Gen. 1:1). We have come to worship the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (Acts 3:13). Most importantly, we have come to worship the God and Father of Jesus Christ who redeemed us through His blood (Jn. 15:23).

We also cannot approach that God in a pompous way. We have to approach Him knowing how great He is and how insignificant we are. When we approach His throne to worship, we should think about how we were nothing but the dust of the ground until *He* formed us (Gen. 2:7). Furthermore, we should respond the same way that Isaiah did when he was in the presence of the King. He said in Isaiah 6:5, "Then said I, woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts."
