The Psalms' Attitude Toward Worship (Pt. 4)

Psalm 100 is all about the worship and adoration of Yahweh God from His covenant people. And each of the just five verses of that Psalm tell us something different about when we come to worship Him as our God. The first verse of that says, "Make a joyful shout to the LORD, all you lands!"

We in the Churches of Christ so often put a lot of emphasis on solely what we *do* in worship. We often emphasize the acts of worship (prayers, singing, preaching, Lord's Supper). We do so correctly because the denominational world so often adds or subtracts from what God has authorized for our worship. After all, Jesus said that the Father was seeking worshippers who worship Him in "truth" (Jn. 4:23-24). However, we can forget that He also said to worship Him with our "spirit."

God is just as concerned with our attitude in worship as He is what we're physically doing. So how do we gauge if we're worshipping joyfully with our spirits or not? I believe the simplest way to do so is to consider where our minds are in worship. While we should be worshipping God in various ways throughout the week, the worship assembly only takes 1-3 hours of our week. Does God not deserve us to *at least* dedicate those brief time periods solely and utterly to Him?
