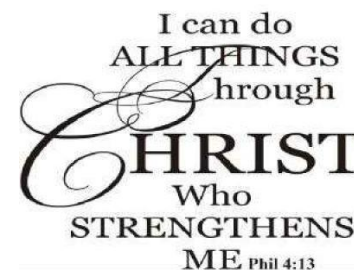
- A potluck meal occurs on the second Sunday of each month
