## **“The Excellencies Of The Law Of God” (Pt. 1)**

Psalm 119 is the longest of our chapters of the Bible. It spans a whole 176 divisions of verses. Considering it's length, it's then fascinating that the entirety of it is dedicated to one singular subject. The unidentified (and often speculated) Psalmist spends all 176 verses explaining and extolling the Law of God.

The first word in the Psalm is the word “blessed.” Other translations say “happy.” It carries the notion of being highly favored. The Psalmist sets the stage for the entire Psalm by saying, “Blessed/Happy are the undefiled in the way, who walk in the Law of the LORD!” (Psa. 119:1). He also uses the word “walk” which means adherence to whatever the subject is. The subject is obviously “the Law of the LORD.”

The lesson is simple cause and effect. If you adhere or live according to God's Word, you will be highly favored by “the High and Lofty One” (Isa. 57:15). God has already endued all of mankind with intrinsic value, being made in His image (Gen. 1:26-27). But we can go beyond that by being favored by God by walking in His Word. That fact in of itself ought to motivate us to be good students both academically and practically.
