## MINISTER'S MESSAGE



### **The Excellencies Of The Law Of God (Pt. 14)**

From an outsiders prospective, I could understand why others might think Christians are wasting their time. That we are flushing our very limited time down the drain by studying the Bible, attending worship services, and the like. Of course they would think or say these things out of ignorance, not knowing the blessings of being a child of God. In Psalm 119:165, the Psalmist writes, "Those who love Your Law have great peace, and nothing causes them to stumble."

This world is full of turmoil. At seemingly every corner, there is another opportunity to stress over something. We have all suffered heartbreaks in different forms. However, Paul tells us that those who rely on the Lord (those who still love God's Law) have "the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension," and that it will guard our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus (Phil. 4:7).
