MINISTER'S MESSAGE



What's In A Name?

Last Sunday morning we looked at Romans 2:17-29. And we saw there that Paul was pointing out the hypocrisy of the Jewish people. He began that section by saying in verse 17, "Indeed you are called a Jew, and rest on the Law, and make your boast in God..." He goes on to talk about the fact that they knew the Law and taught it to others, but that they forgot to teach themselves first. But just the fact that they were Jews was something that they found contentment in. They seemed to expect salvation simply by virtue of being of the seed of Abraham (Gal. 3:29).

Earlier in that chapter, Paul told us that our works matter. They matter because God is going to judge us according to our works (Rom. 2:5-6). That is what the Jews could not seem to grasp. It isn't who's descendant you are or who's last name you bear, but what you've done and who you are as an individual. The Jews found salvation in being a Jew and going to the Temple. We also cannot be saved solely by virtue of being a Christian and going to worship. It isn't the name that we bear that will save us, but rather the grace of God as demonstrated through the shedding of the blood of His Son. So let us not be satisfied with only carrying the name Christian, but live up to it with our actions.
