## MINISTER'S MESSAGE



### **The Excellencies Of The Law Of God (Pt. 13)**

The Psalmist makes a peculiar statement in Psalm 119:164. He says there, "Seven times a day I praise You, because of Your righteous ordinances." I find this to be a peculiar statement because he designated a specific number of times where he praised God. There was no law in the Old Law that designated this number as how many times one should praise God. Therefore, this was a personal commitment that the Psalmist made.

The number seven is most likely no coincidence. Sometime go and search the word "seven" in the books of Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy. Seven was the number that was featured over and over again in the Old Law practices. It is often associated with perfection or completeness. At the very least, it is a number that is associated with God.

But what this commitment to praise God seven times a day suggests to me is *conviction and commitment*. This is a concerted effort to praise God throughout his entire day. There would not be any general part of his day where he did not think about God and give Him the glory for each part of it. So while there is no precedent to say that we have to worship seven times a day, to have an attitude similar to his would be more than prudent.
