MINISTER'S MESSAGE



Nothing But Noise

In the book of Amos, as is the case with the rest of his prophetic counterparts, Amos is detailing the sins of God's chosen people in the northern kingdom of Israel. He preached a message of repentance in light of the impending judgment of Yahweh through the wicked nation of Assyria. But even though Israel were themselves wicked, they remained going through the motions and practicing the outward actions of the Law. Yahweh cared nothing for this and told them to stop the noise of their heartless worship. He says this in Amos 5:23, "Take away from Me the noise of your songs; I will not even listen to the sound of your harps." Where they believed that they were worshipping, God saw it as nothing but noise.

When relating this ancient passage to us today, we can miss the mark. We might want to only apply this passage to those who use mechanical instruments in their "worship" whenever God has not authorized such an action in the New Testament. And that would certainly apply. However, this could potentially be directed toward us as well. If our heart is not engaged in worship, there is no reason to believe that God does not look at it the same way that He did with Israel. If we only perform the outward actions of worship, with no internal conviction, I fear He would still tell us today, "Take away from Me the noise of your songs."
