## MINISTER'S MESSAGE



### **The Psalms' Attitude Toward Worship (Pt. 8)**

Through Psalm 100:1-4, what has the Psalmist said about our worshipping God? That we are to shout to Him joyfully (1), that we serve Him gladly and sing to Him (2), to know who He is and that we are His people (3), and that we enter his gates and courts with thanksgiving and praise (4). In the concluding verse, the Psalmist tells us *why* we are to do all these things. He says, "For the LORD is good; His mercy is everlasting, and His truth endures to all generations."

It seems like an understatement to say that God is "good." But it is actually a deeply profound statement. His entire being is good. Where we deal with a cruel world on a daily basis, He is a breath of fresh air because everything about Him and everything He does is *good*. Which is in part why He is worthy of our praise. He could have been a cruel tyrant and still been the Sovereign Ruler of the Universe. But of His volition, He made the decision to be good toward us. Whenever we come to worship God, in case we forget who it is that we've come to give honor and praise, remember how God described Himself in Exodus 34:6. He told Moses, "The LORD, the LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth."
