MINISTER'S MESSAGE



Proverbs 15:1-4

When we think about what the Scriptures have to say about the power of the tongue, what we might think of is James 3. There we find the brother of our Lord liken the tongue to other small things that have great power such as bits in a horse's mouth, the rudder of a ship, and a spark that ignites a forest fire. Solomon also gives us reasons to control our tongue in Proverbs 15:1-4. Here are four simple points that can help us restrain our tongue this week:

We control our tongue because it can harm others ("A gentle answer turns away wrath, But a harsh word stirs up anger")

We control our tongue because we value wisdom ("The tongue of the wise makes knowledge acceptable, but the mouth of fools spouts folly")

We control our tongue because the LORD sees us ("The eyes of the LORD are in every place, watching the evil and the good")

We control our tongue because it can make or break our spirit ("A soothing tongue is a tree of life, but perversion in it crushes the spirit")
