MINISTER'S MESSAGE



The Excellencies Of The Law Of God (Pt. 11)

In Psalm 119:116, in the midst of speaking about the Word/Law of God, the Psalmist makes a request to God. He said, "Sustain me according to Your Word, that I may live; and do not let me be ashamed of my hope." As Christians, the importance of hope cannot be overstated. We know that faith is of the utmost importance. Hope is just as important if not more, seeing as it is simply faith extended into the future. It is the ability to be sure of things that have not come yet, and on this side of eternity, we hope in things that are invisible. Paul made this clear in Romans 8:24 by saying, "For in hope we have been saved, but hope that is seen is not hope; for who hopes for what he already sees?"

The lesson from Psalm 119:116 is that we should cling to the Word and not the world. Why? Because the world is going to try to convince us to give up on our hope. The world is going to try to convince us that believing in the invisible is irrational. The Word on the other hand reminds us that just because something is invisible does not have any necessary bearing on its existence. The Word will remind us that God has always kept His promises and therefore will continue to. Being reminded of these facts will allow the Word to sustain us and not allow us to be ashamed of our hope just like the Psalmist of old requested.
