MINISTER'S MESSAGE



The Beatitudes (6/9)

Continuing in the succession of the Beatitudes, Jesus gets broad with the next one when He says, "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God." That is both a lofty goal and an incredible reward. Becoming pure in heart is a tall task. But as tall a task as becoming pure in heart is, one day seeing God is a reward that outweighs the challenge.

What does it mean to be pure in heart? The greatest way to describe this was an object lesson that our Lord gave in Matthew 18. The Bible says in Matthew 18:1-5, "At that time the disciples came to Jesus, saying, "Who then is greatest in the kingdom of heaven?" Then Jesus called a little child to Him, set him in the midst of them, and said, 'Assuredly, I say to you, unless you are converted and become as little children, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven. Therefore whoever humbles himself as this little child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven. Whoever receives one little child like this in My name receives Me.'" Becoming pure in heart is becoming as innocent as a child at heart. This is not to say that we lose all of the sense gained by our experiences, but rather having the general, pure outlook on life as a child does.

Once again, the reward outweighs the challenge. We want to see God. We are going through this life giving Him the glory, and we do so in the hopes that we will one day see our Creator. Purity in heart surely is not the only aspect that we need keep in our lives to attain seeing our God, but Jesus lets us know that it is of the utmost importance.
