## MINISTER'S MESSAGE



### **The Excellencies Of The Law Of God (Pt. 10)**

One of the most noted portions of Psalm 119 is verse 105. There the Psalmist writes, "Your Word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path." Often we take having the Word of God in our possession and ready to read at any time, for granted. I have always grown up with multiple Bibles available to me at any time. Since that is true for many people, we don't often think about what life would be like if we didn't have the Word to light the way for us.

If we didn't have the Word to guide us, we would be in the dark spiritually. Deuteronomy 29:29 tells us that God reveals what He needs us to know but keeps the "secret things" for Himself. Obviously had He not revealed anything to us, everything would be things that are secret and known only to Him. I could still observe from creation that there is a God, but wouldn't know what His will for me was.

Also, if we didn't have the Word to guide us, we would be susceptible to being misguided. A few verses later, the Psalmist says that he used God's Word to refuse the snare of the wicked. He said in verse 110, "The wicked have laid a snare for me, yet I have not gone astray from Your precepts." We would be prey to believe anything others wanted us to believe if we didn't have the Word to keep us rooted. But because we have our light and guide available to us, we can "test the spirits to see whether they are from God" (1 Jn. 4:1).
