## MINISTER'S MESSAGE



### **The Psalms' Attitude Toward Worship (Pt. 3)**

Psalm 146 is a Psalm that is dedicated to simply exclaiming who God is and what He does. Specifically that we can put our trust in Him (5), that He made heaven and earth (6), that He executes justice (7), opens the eyes of the blind (8), watches over the helpless (9), and reigns forever (10). And all of these descriptions of God's works and characteristics caused Him to open up the Psalm by saying, "Praise the LORD! Praise the LORD, O my soul! I will praise the LORD as long as I live; I will sing praises to my God while I have my being" (Psa. 146:1-2).

What I want to highlight from that Psalm is that the unidentified Psalmist said that He would praise God as long as he lived. Sometimes we say that when we come together to this place that we are "going to church." A more accurate description of what we come together to do is to *worship*. That is not to suggest, however, that the worship that we offer to God begins and ends 11 AM-12 PM and/or 6 PM-7 PM on Sundays. Our worship needs to extend to Mondays-Saturdays as well. Not that every little insignificant action is worship, but that in all that we do and say, we should prompt others to "see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven" (Matt. 5:16).
