MINISTER'S MESSAGE



First Things First

John wrote in 1 John 5:3, "For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome." We know this to be true. But we also know that we can be overwhelmed by the magnitude of God's Word. Whenever we think that it is too big or too confusing, we ought to direct our minds toward the reason that we have it in the first place.

As Israel was preparing to enter the Promised Land, Moses reminded Israel of what should be on the forefronts of their minds. He said in Deut. 6:4-5, "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one! You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength." Jesus would reinstate this great command when he said, "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another" (Jn. 13:34).

Love is the overarching theme of Scripture and it is what *moved* God to act on our behalf. And when we begin to feel overwhelmed by the sheer amount of Scripture and it's expectations of us, simply remember these things. That God loves us with an undying, unconditional passion, and that we are to mimic Him by being loving ourselves. We ought to love Him, love others, *and* love self in that very order.
