MINISTER'S MESSAGE



The Beatitudes of Revelation (4/5)

In Revelation 20, we find the binding of Satan. John records an angel coming down from heaven and laying hold of Satan, binding him for a thousand years (Rev. 20:1-3). John also describes the prevailing of the saints who were killed for their faith (Rev. 20:4-5). He describes this prevailing as “the first resurrection.” This is the first resurrection because the second resurrection is the resurrection of the body when the Lord returns (1 Cor. 15:50-55). In 20:6, John writes, “*Blessed* and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.”

Obviously we do not have to have a part in the first resurrection as they did. We aren't faced with a murderous, vindictive government as the Christians under Rome were. We still have much to overcome ourselves. These lives are difficult. There are hurdles that we must overcome on a daily basis. Whether it be temptations to deny, mental health struggles that bog us down, or just seemingly slight inconveniences, there is much we have to deal with. But we find our hope in the reality of the second resurrection. When one day our bodies are changed. When we shed the frailty of these bodies. When we do, all of the problems of this life will be shed as well (Rev. 7:17; 21:4).
