MINISTER'S MESSAGE



Misconceptions About God

In Deuteronomy 1, Moses is recounting the history of Israel from the Exodus up until what was then the present day when the second generation of Israel came about.

Unfortunately, much of what Moses reminds them of is very negative. One thing that catches my eye is 1:26-27. There he said, "Yet you were not willing to go up, but rebelled against the command of the LORD your God; and you grumbled in your tents and said, 'Because the LORD hates us, He has brought us out of the land of Egypt to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites to destroy us.'" Israel had a misconception about God that deeply affected their relationship with Him. Where the LORD wanted them to trust in Him in order to lead them to victory, they perceived that the strength of the enemy was due to God's hatred for them. Moses corrects their mindset when he told them that He was ready to fight on their behalf just as He did in Egypt (1:30).

Many to this day obviously have misconceptions about God that lead to dangerous conclusions. One example of that is the idea that God pre-ordained everything and that my actions are therefore not my own choice. And so if I cannot truly choose to do anything, then it really does not matter what I do or how I live since the decision to do it was not my own. This is only one example. We must look into the Word of God to see who our God truly is. If we did, we would see that He does not hate us and has given us free will. Understanding who He is will help us understand who we are and what we ought to do in these lives.
