MINISTER'S MESSAGE



Keep It Simple!

We human beings have a tendency to overcomplicate things. We overthink situations that are as straightforward as can be. Whenever a problem required a simple solution, perhaps we spent hours second-guessing ourselves about how to find a solution. And when it comes to our obligation to abide by the Word of God, we can overcomplicate that process as well.

Moses said, "For this commandment which I command you today is not too mysterious for you, nor is it far off. It is not in heaven, that you should say, 'Who will ascend into heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?' Nor is it beyond the sea, that you should say, 'Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?' But the Word is very near you, in your mouth and in your heart, that you may do it" (Deut. 30:11-14). He tells us there that God's Word is, as a whole, relatively easy to understand.

Since God's Word is not, as a whole, too mysterious or confusing, what our reaction to it should be is obvious. If the Bible explicitly teaches something, do it! If it tells us to explicitly not do something, don't do it! If it is silent on a matter, don't necessarily do it. This article may seem overly obvious. However, given our tendency to overcomplicate things, I find it imperative to remind each of us that sometimes things are just that simple. Simply fear God and keep His commandments which are not overly burdensome (Eccl. 12:13; 1 Jn. 5:3).
