MINISTER'S MESSAGE



The Excellencies Of The Law Of God (Pt. 12)

“Rivers of water run down from my eyes, because men do not keep Your Law.” Those were the inner feelings of the Psalmist as stated in Psalm 119:136. David told us in Psalm 37:5 to “Commit your way to the LORD, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass.” This sounds similar to what David’s son Solomon wrote, saying, “Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths” (Prov. 3:5). These verses let us know that the LORD ultimately knows what is best for us. Therefore, to abide by His Word would be what is best for us.

When we, like the Psalmist, observe others who don’t keep God’s Law, what is our reaction? We see from what he wrote what our response *should* be. However, many Christians instead opt to view unbelievers as being lesser than them. We can use our obedience as a tool to prop ourselves up as being better than them. Instead, we should be pricked to the heart over it. In Psalm 14, the LORD was grieved in His heart because He looked at the earth and saw that none were righteous. If we want to be more like Him, we would do well to have a similar response to unbelievers. And those feelings should prompt us to exhort them (with love and long-suffering) to turn from their ways “so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord” (Acts 3:19).
