MINISTER'S MESSAGE



The Psalms' Attitude Toward Worship (Pt. 1)

When a worship service is opened and a man reads a passage of Scripture to help the congregation get in the right frame of mind, chances are that he will be quoting from the Psalms. The phrase, "Praise Yahweh"/"Praise the LORD" is said 39 times in the Psalms. So I found it appropriate to briefly note what it says about worship as we have come here to do just that on the first day of the week.

One of the simplest statements made about worship is found near the end of the collection in Psalm 147:1. The Psalmist says, "Praise Yahweh! For it is good to sing praises to our God; for it is pleasant and praise is becoming." What does he tell us about worship? Simply that it is good, pleasant, and becoming/beautiful. To say that worship is good seems to be an understatement until we see that that simple term is exactly how God is described 5 times in the Psalms. Psalm 106:1 reads, "Praise Yahweh! Oh give thanks to Yahweh, *for He is good*; for His lovingkindness endures forever." We find there that the beauty of worship is compared to the beauty of the One whom it is being offered to. And so since worship is put on this pedestal of great importance, how could we ever miss out on an opportunity to do so?
